### Internship Program

The Internship Program is designed to provide practitioners with direct experience with the older client, their families, and the organizations serving them. Under the guidance and direction of a supervisor, this third course in the EMTP™ series puts the practitioner “in the room” to observe, interview, and progress to facilitate discussions as a co-mediator/facilitator and sole mediator/facilitator.

The number of hours of supervision will be organized between the intern and the supervisor, and may depend on whether the internship hours will be used towards accreditation in one of the organizations that have established standards for obtaining membership and credentials.

An intern’s progress will be reviewed on a regular basis by the Program’s Supervisors and Director; self-evaluations are also part of the Program.

Our interns will have completed both the Introductory and Advanced Course of the EMTP™, or Equivalency (determined in discussion with the Program Director).

Interns pay a fixed fee for their supervision hours. All interns must have liability insurance.

Admission\* to the Internship Program is by application, and subject to availability of supervisors and the suitability of the applicant.
